Covid 19 Guidelines

Team Managers

Welcome to the 9th Annual Crystal Coast Wood Bat World Series. **Please distribute** the following **Covid 19 Recommendations** to all family, and extended family members that will be attending this year's event. It is important that everyone does their part to limit interaction with others while practicing Social Distancing. Please recognize, and be respectful to the space of other individuals and families at all times. The frequent use of handsanitizer, antibacterial wipes or other personal sanitary products are strongly recommended. All spectators should bring an adequate supply of these items with them each day of the event. These items will not be available for purchase at any of the venues.

Spectators & Fans.

- **Social Distancing:** Spectators should stay 6 feet apart at all times unless with family members.
- **Only 25 Spectators per team** will be allowed to enter the park. This does not include coaches and players.
- **Please do not come to the park** if you are feeling ill, or, if you have a temperature above 100.4 degrees.
- **When you arrive at the park**, PLEASE allow the other families adequate time to leave the designated spectator area before you begin assembling your tents and placing your chairs.
- **Designated Spectator Area:** The Bleachers behind Home Plate and along both Foul Lines will be closed at all parks. The Spectator Area will be marked at each field utilizing a portion of each foul line and the outfield area where applicable. You should bring your own chairs. Tents will be allowed, and should only be shared with family members.
- **Unless Playing Back To Back Games** PLEASE be prepared to exit the Spectator Area immediately.
- **Between Games:** If your team has a break between games, please exit to the Parking Area with your family members. It is recommended that you wait in your vehicles with your family or find an activity away from the park. All post game related Team / family activities should be held away from the park. **This would include “tailgating”**, even with immediate family. Please make room for others to navigate the parking areas.
- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)** Masks, Gloves, and other PPE items may reduce the spread of germs. The use of PPE items is highly recommended when in close proximity to non family members.
- **Personal Coolers of any size will not be allowed in the park.** The sharing of beverages and food among individuals is not recommended. Personal Coolers should remain in your vehicles at all times.
- **Outside Food & Beverages** should be consumed in your vehicle before you enter the park.
- **Sunflower Seeds & Gum** may not be disposed of on the ground at any venue.

Players & Coaches

- **Parents should provide their child** with an adequate supply of hand sanitizer or antibacterial wipes for the event. These should be used frequently throughout each game played..
- **Each player and coach must bring a small personal cooler or water bottle.** Sharing is not recommended unless with a family member. **NO TEAM COOLERS.**

- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)** Masks, Gloves, and other PPE items may help reduce the spread of germs and are recommended when in close contact with non family members. Coaches and Players may use PPE items at any time, on or off the field. Note: Make sure that any PPE items used does not hinder or inhibit the safety of the Coach / Player.
- **Equipment should be separated when possible** and sharing among players is not recommended. It is recommended that team and personal equipment be cleaned frequently throughout the event with appropriate sanitizers.
- **Extended Dugouts will be at all venues.** This will include the bleachers behind home plate, foul lines or both where applicable. Designated areas will be marked to help with spacing.
- **When a team is hitting**, one batter will be at the plate, one on deck, and one in the field dugout. All other players and coaches will occupy the extended dugout area socially distanced from one another. Coaches, we call on you to monitor and maintain the spacing of your players throughout the games.
- **No High Fives**, Handshakes, Fist Bumps or other celebratory contact before, during or after a game among players, coaches or umpires.
- **No Infield, pre game or post game meetings.** Unless playing back to back games all teams should clean, and then clear their respective dugouts and exit to the parking area as quickly as possible. It is imperative that we minimize the number of people in the park at all times.

Our Tournament Staff & Other Information

- Our tournament staff at the park will wear masks and any other necessary PPE when in close contact with those attending the event. They will also work to comply with Social Distancing among themselves and in their interactions with our guests.
- A key component to the game schedule is to allow adequate “buffer” time between games to allow for teams that are coming and going. Please be on time to play, and when finished please help us by exiting to the parking area in a timely manner.
