We are excited to be hosting this event at Hank Aaron Stadium!

Press Box Preparation:

- Please provide player rosters with full names (first and last), uniform numbers and name pronunciations as needed.
- Please provide a team logo for the video board.
- Please email to kevin@mobileseg.com as soon as possible for press box prep.

Tickets:

- Tickets are \$10 for Day Pass per day per person or \$25 for Tournament Pass per person
- Field-Level Suites with AC are available for \$100 per day (not including tickets). Please call Brandy at 251.572.2327 to reserve a Suite.

Stadium Entry Rules:

- Gates will open 1 hour before the first scheduled game of the day
- Everyone entering the stadium through the front gate must have a ticket to enter the stadium
- All bags will be checked at the front gate / No outside food or drink / No personal coolers
- No pets
- No weapons of any kind
- All players and coaches must enter the stadium through the Player/Coach Gate

Player/Coach Entry (see map):

- All players and coaches must enter the stadium through the Player/Coaches Gate located behind the batting cages behind right field. All bags will be checked at the front gate and no outside food or drinks will be allowed to enter through the front gate. Players may have water/drinks in their bags and will not be checked at the Player/Coaches Gate.



Team Cooler:

- Due to Covid restrictions, there will be no water coolers provided in the dugouts. A team cooler will be allowed. However, team coolers will not be allowed into the stadium through the front gate. Like all players and coaches, any team that wishes to bring a team cooler into the stadium must do so through the Player/Coaches Gate.

Batting Cages:

- We have 2 covered, lighted batting cages that will be available to use. No spikes are allowed in the batting cages at any time. Turf or tennis shoes only. Teams must provide their own baseballs and are required to keep trash picked up in and around the cages.

Between Games:

- We don't really have a warm up area. We will spray the dugouts with disinfectant prior to each game unless a team is playing back to back games, so teams will have time in between games to warm up in the outfield as we prep the field for the next game. Please do not allow players to enter the dugouts until our staff has finished with the disinfecting process. We ask that players respect the facility and playing surface. Teams are asked to pick up trash in the dugouts after each game and we ask that players stay on the warning track going to and exiting the dugouts before and after games and not roll bags or coolers on the grass. Playing catch is not allowed on the grass areas in foul territory in front of the dugouts. There is plenty of room in the outfield.

Health Precautions:

- The Mobile Sports & Entertainment Group and Hank Aaron Stadium staff are adhering to recommended health guidelines during the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Signs are posted and we ask that patrons practice social distancing by maintaining a 6 foot distance between others at all times throughout the stadium. We are maintaining a thorough cleaning cycle. All high-touch surfaces are disinfected regularly and we ask that patrons practice healthy hygiene by washing your hands frequently, covering any coughs or sneezes and refrain from spitting. We will continue to monitor recommendations from the CDC and our local and state health departments, and we will follow all guidelines to help prevent the spread of the virus. The health and safety of our guests and employees is our top priority.
